APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

PRELIMINARY REMARKS

We encourage outstanding (top 10%) students with a university degree (bachelor or master) in economics or related fields, such as mathematics, statistics, business administration, accounting, and finance, to apply for admission.

The application deadline for the program starting in October is January 15.

Please note, to be considered, your application must be complete by this date. Essential documents, particularly letters of recommendation, must arrive by the deadline; late submissions will render the application incomplete. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

If you have not yet completed your university degree but will do so before the BGSE program starts, you are of course also invited to apply. In that case, you will be asked to enter relevant information about your current studies during the online application process.

YOU WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS TO APPLY (INCL. GRANT APPLICATION AND CONDITIONAL OFFER TO PROCEED TO OUR DOCTORAL PROGRAM):

your application material checklist:

- (1) GRE
- (2) TOEFL or IELTS (if required)
- (3) two letters of recommendation (uploaded by your professors)
- (4) statement of academic purpose
- (5) CV
- (6) academic transcripts
- (7) APS certificate (if required)

(1) GRE score report (General Test Format)*

The average **quantitative GRE score** of our successful applicants has been 165. There is no point in applying if your GRE quantitative score is below 160. If you have not reached 160 points, we recommend you to re-take the exam and to apply once you have improved your score.

The BGSE accepts the GRE General Test at Home.

(2) TOEFL or IELTS (academic format) score report is required if English is not your first language or if the language of instruction of your previous degree is not English (curriculum must have been taught exclusively in English)*

A TOEFL iBT score of at least 100 with at least 23 in each of the 4 sections is the minimum requirement. There is no point in applying if your TOEFL iBT score is below that. If you have not reached these scores, we recommend you to re-take the exam and to apply once you have improved your scores.

The BGSE accepts the TOEFL iBT® Special Home Edition.

The minimum requirements for **IELTS** scores (academic format) are: Overall 7.0; Reading 6.5; Listening 6.5; Writing 7.0; Speaking 6.5. If you have not reached these scores, we recommend you to re-take the exam and to apply once you have improved your scores.

(3) Furthermore, you need to ask two of your academic teachers to provide a confidential letter of recommendation to the BGSE.

Please ask your professors to preferably address the following two questions:

- 1) Does the candidate belong to the top 5% or top 10% of his or her cohort (size of the cohort)?
- 2) Is the candidate likely to perform well in a competitive, structured Ph.D. program with a high analytic content?

Once you have <u>submitted</u> your application, your professors will get an automatically generated email with some instructions and an upload link.

When submitting your online application, be prepared to also have the following documents ready as pdf files for uploading:

- (4) Your **statement of academic purpose** should outline your academic background, research interests, and career goals, ideally articulating how these align with the expertise of our faculty members. The statement should also explain your specific research areas of interest and your objectives for graduate study.
- (5) curriculum vitae,
- (6) academic transcripts (transcript of record, university degree/s, diploma supplements).
- (7) **APS certificate** is mandatory for applicants from China (except Hong Kong), India, Mongolia or Vietnam; included with the application or once they receive an offer.

*Please upload an official copy of your GRE / TOEFL report and instruct (<u>ETS</u>) to give us official access to your scores so we confirm them via their online portal. Our institute number at ETS is 1359. We cannot accept a screenshot of your score or unofficial pdf taken from your personal account with ETS.

We advise you not to leave your application until the very last minute – should you face technical problems and not be able to submit your application on time or will reference letters arrive after January 15, the BGSE, unfortunately, cannot accept your application.

GUIDE FOR THE ONLINE APPLICATION PORTAL

This guide was designed to help you submit your application to the Bonn Graduate School of Economics (BGSE) via the Online Application Portal of the University of Bonn.

When accessing the Online Application Portal, you can choose between two languages (German and English) in the upper right corner of the screen. Make sure to use the English language version.

If this is the first time you access the portal, please make yourself familiar with the application procedure by choosing the respective link (*Application Procedure*) on the menu.

Before you can start your application (click on New Application), you need to register:

When registering, you will be asked to fill in some personal data. After you have done so, you can immediately log in to start the application procedure with your chosen username and password.

NOTE: If you want to continue your application or check the status of your application *after you* have already registered and started the application procedure, do **not** try to access your application via New Application \rightarrow Login. Instead, click on Status at the center of the page to log in and continue with your application or review it.

QUESTIONNAIRE (STANDARDIZED, DIGITAL INTERVIEW)

You will first go through a small catalogue of questions that was designed to find out whether you meet the basic requirements of the combined M.Sc. Economic Research / Doctoral Program at the Bonn Graduate School of Economics. Please choose "Dr. rer. pol. (Ph.D. equivalent) incl. research master" and as a second step "Economic Research M.Sc./Ph.D. track" for the combined M.Sc./Doctoral Program.

At the end of the questionnaire, you can review your answers, make corrections if necessary, and verify your data before continuing to the application itself. Once the data has been verified, you will not be able to return to the interview. Please make sure you read all the instructions carefully.

Note on Language Skills:

Please note that the BGSE only accepts IELTS or TOEFL score reports as proof of English language skills. You don't need to submit IELTS or TOEFL scores if you are a native speaker or if your previous degree has been instructed in English exclusively.

Note on References:

You need to ask two of your academic teachers to provide a confidential letter of recommendation to the BGSE. Please ask your professors to preferably address the following two questions:

- 1) Does the candidate belong to the top 5% or top 10% of his or her cohort (size of the cohort)?
- 2) Is the candidate likely to perform well in a competitive, structured Ph.D. program with a high analytic content?

Once you have completed your application, your professors will get an automatically generated email with some instructions and an upload link.

Note on Upload Area:

All uploaded files have to be in pdf format. The size must not exceed 2000 kByte.

Note on forwarding your application material to the regular M.Sc. in Economics program:

Towards the end of the application procedure, you will be asked if your application should automatically be considered for the regular M.S.c in Economics in case your application for the research/Ph.D. track with a scholarship is not successful. If you choose "yes", your material will be evaluated for the regular master program. Please note that acceptance for the regular master program comes *without a scholarship and without a conditional offer for our doctoral program*. Anyhow, you would still have the option to specialize in economic research and take the compatible classes.

Completing the application:

Once you have completed the application procedure by filling in all required information and by uploading all necessary documents, the menu will state that you have not yet sent your application and asks you to click on *send*.

If you present a detailed offer by another doctoral program, you can ask the BGSE to reach a decision outside the deadlines.
